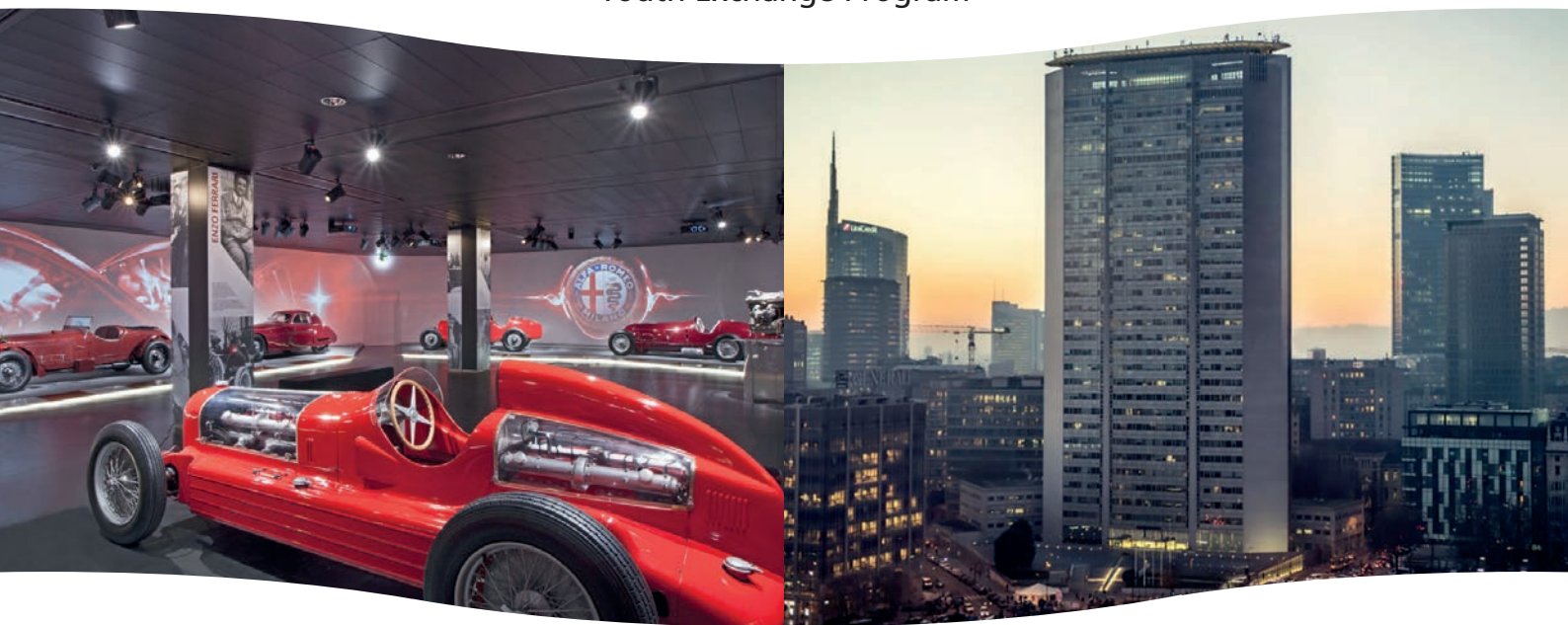




Summer Camp 2022 | July 2nd-July 10th

Discover Milan

Arrival	Saturday, July 2nd, 2022 within 3.00 PM Airports: Milan – Malpensa (PREFERRED) or Linate Milan - Central Railway Station. A Rotary Club Rep will be at the airport/train station to provide assistance and transportation (arrival and departure).
Departure	Sunday - July 10th, 2022
Hosting District	D2041 - Milan (Italy)
Participants	The first 12 registrants will be accepted trying to offer at least 1 place per Country and District pursuing gender balance. The limit of 12 is mandatory.
Age	18 - 25 years old
Language	English
Cost	400 euros (the cost includes insurance, food, accommodation and transportation during the camp). The Fee must be Net of bank commission.
Other Costs	Participants will have to pay for their trip to/from Milano, and will bring a reasonable amount of pocket money.
Clothes	Casual clothes (Jacket for boys to be dressed during Rotary meetings) Sneakers, swimsuit for pool/ outdoor activities.
Insurance	Included.
Covid-19	All participants must have received at least two doses of EMA (European Medicines Agency) approved COVID vaccines before arriving to the camp. Student must include an official COVID Vaccination Certificate in her/his Application Form.
